Bergoglio

I have been listening to an audio book on Pope Francis over the past couple of weeks. The book was a gift I gratefully received over Christmas.

Father Mario Bergoglio, later Bishop Bergoglio and later Pope Francis has led an interesting life. He has faced challenges like the rest of us and has detractors as well as admirers both within and outside of the Catholic Church.

After listening to many hours of audio, the one word I would use to describe the Pope would be ‘authentic’. It talks of his life and mission throughout the years. The things we witnessed after his ascendancy to the top role have been consistent throughout his life. The washing of the sinners’ feet, both believers and non-believers. The austerity in lodgings and travel. The real concern for the poor of the world. The acceptance of ambiguity in life. The willingness to make decisions, not just popular decisions (this may go some way to explaining the detractors). His demonstration of real leadership in a time of crisis in the Church.

As many regular readers of this column will know, I am a big fan of the Pope. If only we could have more leaders of his character in the Church. If only we could be more authentic in our living of the Gospel messages. Mario Bergoglio shows us how. And that is the test of a real leader.
