ST FRANCIS CHURCH The future of the St Francis' Church was for the Archdiocesan Strategic Plan, specifically the *Growth / Development* Committee, and ultimately for the Archbishop to decide. Submissions were invited to the Archdiocesan Plan regarding the Church's future use. One was received proposing it be redeveloped with a multi-purpose facility serving 3 suburbs. A second proposal was received suggesting a retirement village redevelopment. A third proposal was received from the Maronite Community in Perth and it is their proposal that has been accepted. The Maronite Church is an Eastern Catholic Church. Archbishop Antoine Tabaray was appointed by Pope Francis in 2013 to lead the Maronite Diocese of Australia and he is a member of the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference. The Maronite community will restore the current church, presbytery and possibly the hall bringing the site back to life as a fully operating Catholic Church.

 International Women’s Day

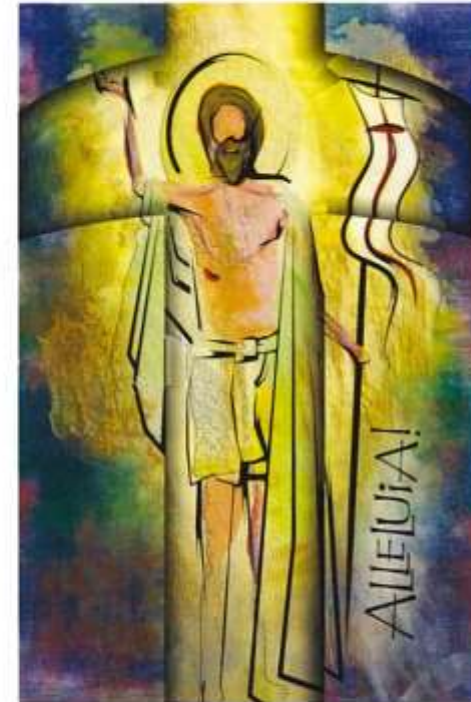
